## Directions to the Wesley Centre 220 Pitt Street Sydney

### By car

Public parking is available directly underneath the Wesley Conference Centre at Secure Parking. Entry is by Piccadilly Plaza, 133 Castlereagh St.

### By train

Town Hall and St James stations provide the closest access to Wesley Conference Centre.

From Town Hall station, exit the platforms via the QVB end of the station. Bear right through the Galleries Victoria shopping mall and take the escalator up to the ground level. Exit the Galleries Victoria onto Pitt St. The Wesley Conference Centre is 50m to the left, on the opposite side of the road from the Galleries Victoria.

From St James Station, exit onto Elizabeth St and continue straight down Market St. Turn left into Pitt St and Wesley Conference Centre is only 50m down on the left hand side.

### By bus

Wesley Conference Centre is close to buses that stop at QVB, Town Hall, Elizabeth St and Castlereagh St.
